MARIE MANTHEY is an American nurse, author, and entrepreneur. She is recognized as one of the originators of Primary Nursing, an innovative system of nursing care delivery. Manthey was named a Living Legend of the American Academy of Nursing in 2015. At the height of her career, Marie became addicted to alcohol and started on a journey in recovery that involved a deep transformation that is now in its 43rd year. Marie helped develop the Nursing Peer Support program in Minnesota that has helped thousands of nurses into recovery and employment. Marie's continued service includes sponsoring women, serving on AA boards, and attending

five International AA Conferences.
